What to pack???

- Bible
- Comfortable, appropriate clothing (sweats, pajamas, tennis shoes)
Check the weather - we will be predominately **OUTDOORS** and will sleep in the buildings at the mission village and/or in tents if weather allows! If weather is unfavorable, we will “Camp” inside the main area of the Ark. We will not use dorms
- Sleeping bag or heavy blanket
- Pillow
- Toiletries (toothbrush/ toothpaste, comb/brush, deodorant, etc. No need for shower essentials - we are “roughing” it.)

Cell Phone Policy

Phones are allowed at Camp Crossway. We ask everyone to put phones away during meal times, group/worship time and at a designated time each night during sleep hours. If a student repeatedly does not abide the cell phone policy, they can choose to leave their phone with the Camp Director or may be asked to leave the property.
